What to Bring to Camp

Camp Tanda is at an elevation of about 6,500 feet. It is warm during the day, but it can get chilly at night. Campers will be in large tent structures. Plan to dress accordingly.

All clothing and equipment should be marked for identification. While the camp takes reasonable precautions, it assumes no responsibility for the camper's personal property.

Bible, Pen/Pencils, notebook

Warm Sleeping Bag or Bedroll (sheets and 2-3 blankets) and Pillow

Warm pajamas

2 warm shirts, 5 light weight shirts no tank tops or spaghetti straps

5 pairs of jeans, pants

2 pairs of shorts must be knee length

6 pairs of socks

6 sets underwear

2 pairs sturdy closed toe shoes and/or hiking boots

Warm jacket or sweater/sweatshirt

2 bath towels and wash cloths

Flashlight (There is no electricity in the cabins)

Bath and personal items: *Comb/Brush, Soap, Shampoo, Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Deodorant, Chap Stick/Lip Balm, Kleenex, Sunscreen*

Water Bottle *1liter size or bigger*

Backpack for carrying items to activities and hiking

Shower Shoes or Flip Flops

Swim Suit/Trunks *with no metal buttons, eyelets, or zippers,*

Cover-up, t-shirt, and beach towel

Remember: No i-pods, MP3's, electronic games or weapons of any kind. No candy or food is allowed in the cabins. Items such as hairspray, gel, and perfumes will attract bugs, like bees and gnats, so think twice before bringing them or wearing them. If you bring a telephone, you must turn it into the Camp Director until camp is over. These rules also apply to all junior staff members.
